

# Great tit

*Parus major*



## What to look for

Largest of the tits, averaging 14cm long

Similar colouring to the blue tit, but with a black 'cap' and breast band

A fairly raucous, metallic call – sounds like 'see-saw' or 'teacher-teacher'.



## Where found

Deciduous and mixed woodland, hedges, gardens and parks.

## When to look

A resident bird so it may be seen throughout the year. Breeds between March and May producing only one brood
